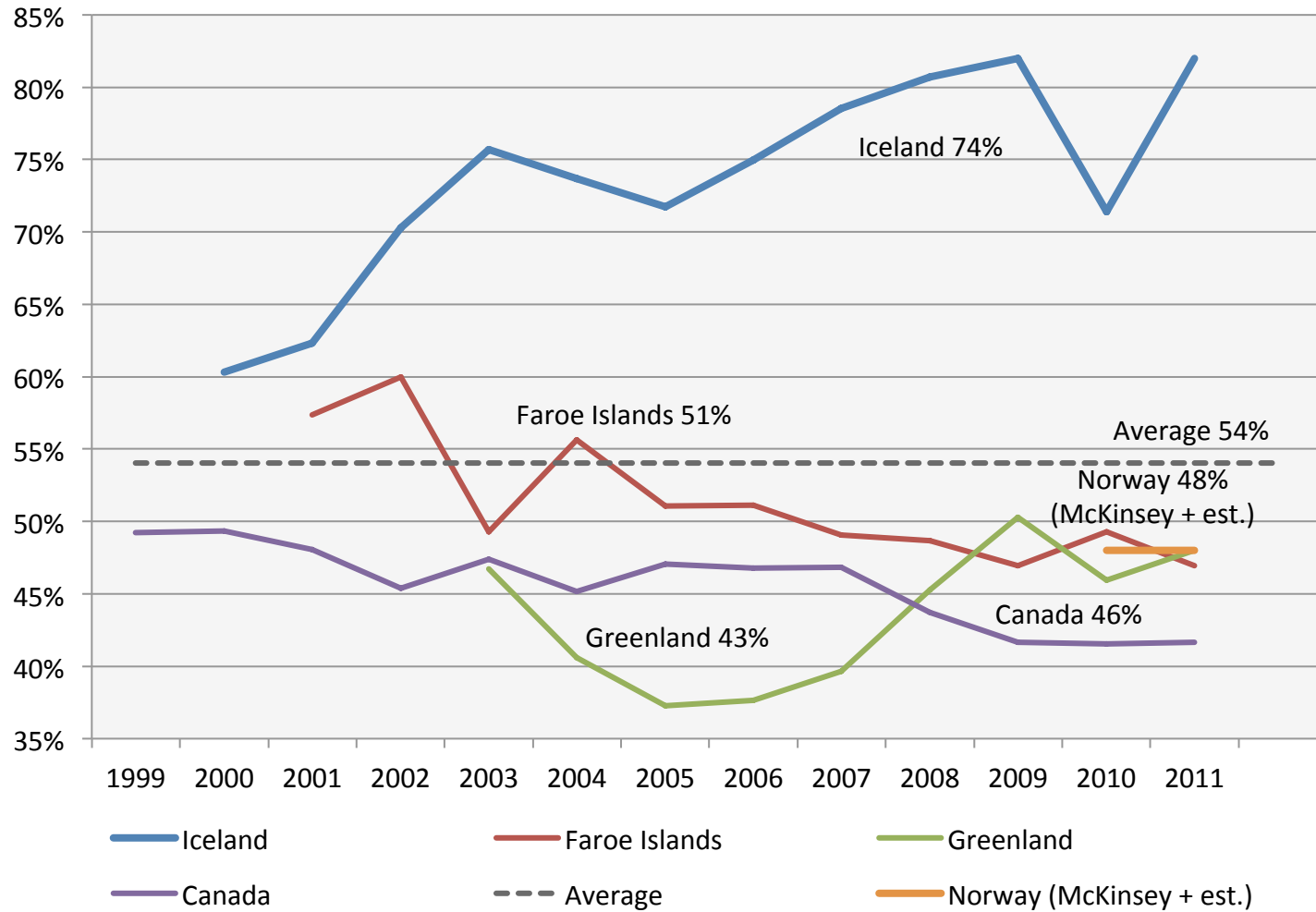

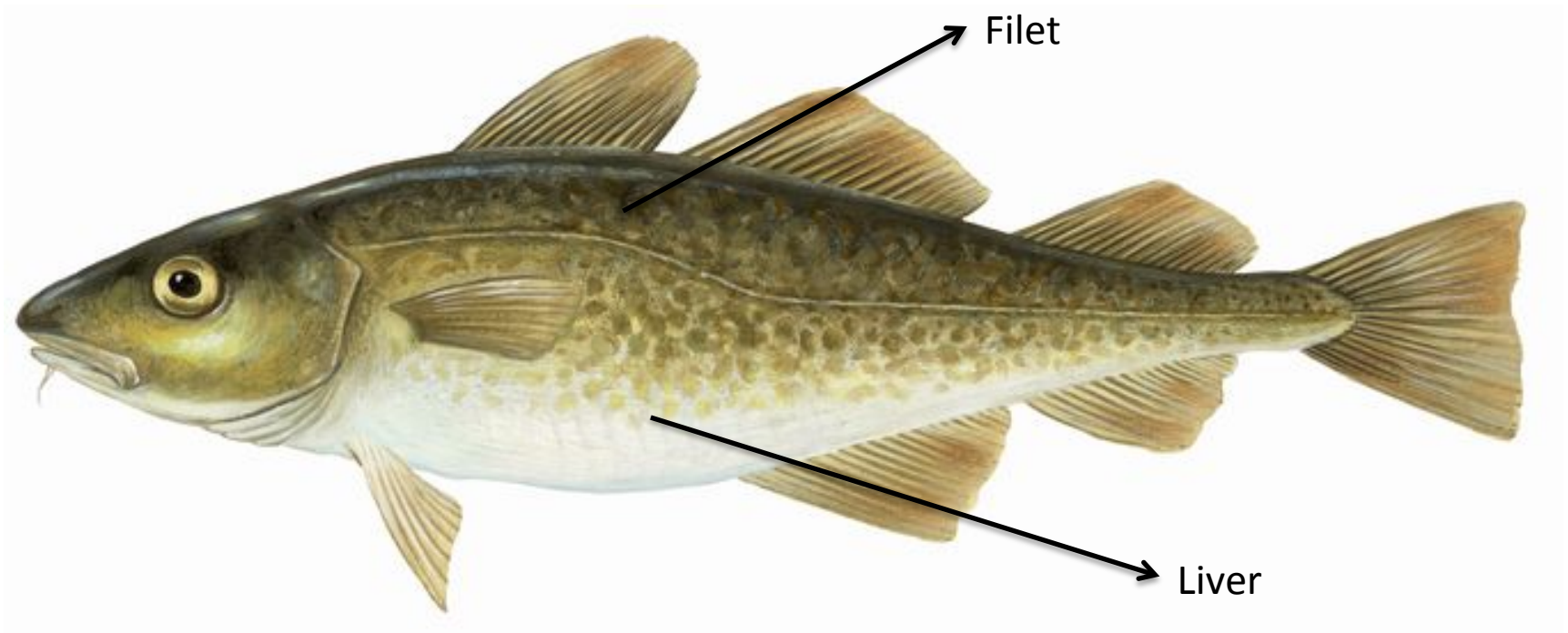
Total catch (cod) and export value

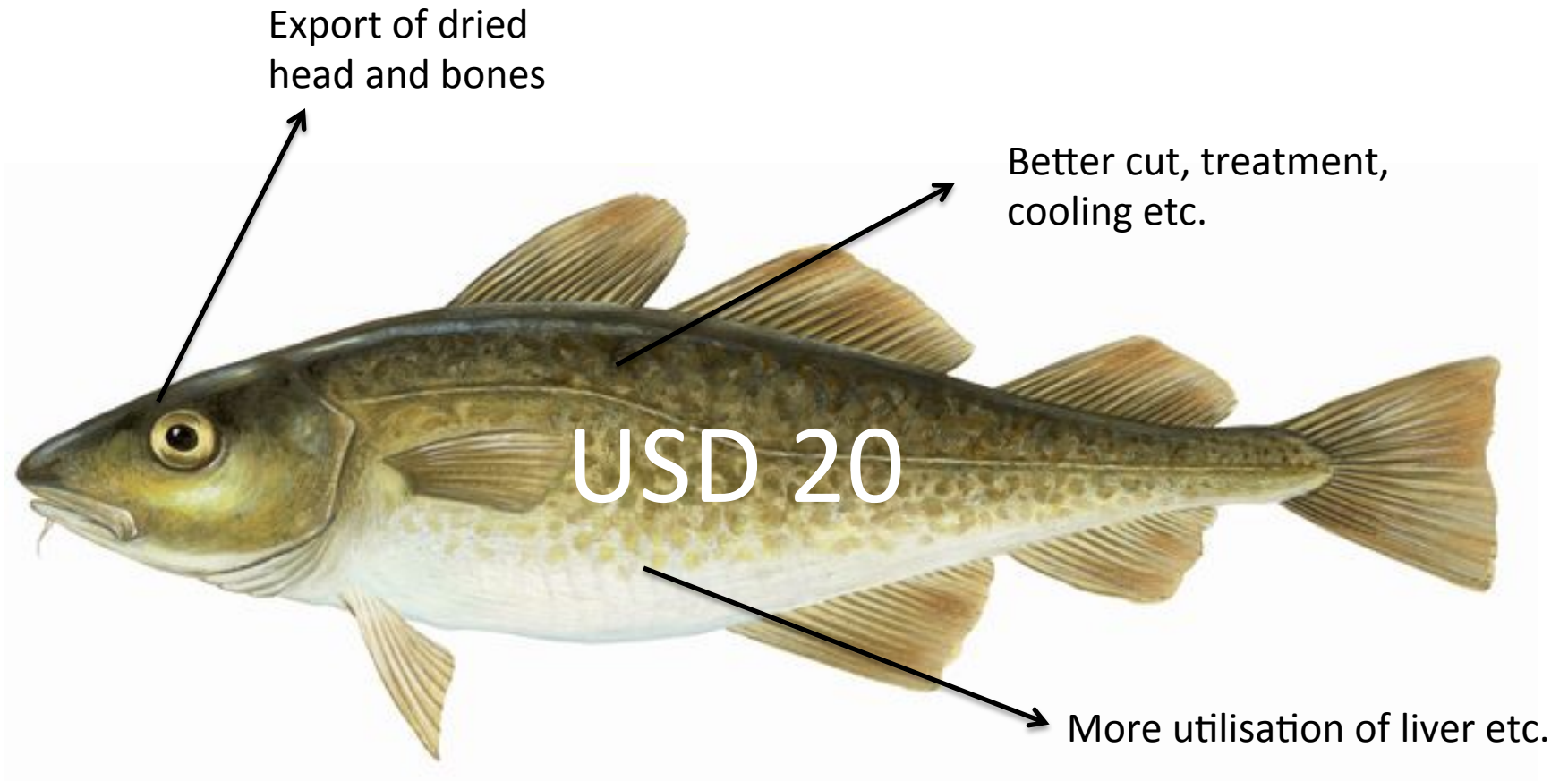
